

2024 Scholarship Application

Deadline March 1, 2024

Eligibility: For applicants to be eligible for this scholarship they must be: 1. be a member, child of, or under the guardianship of a Mecosta County Farm Bureau member; 2. been accepted to attend a post-secondary institution.

Award: Scholarships shall be no less than \$500. Multiple scholarships or scholarships in excess of \$500 may be awarded at the discretion of the Mecosta County Farm Bureau Board of Directors.

Application Requirements:

- 1. Complete all components of application.
- 2. Applicant must submit a letter of recommendation from their coach, teacher, 4-H leader, or FFA advisor.
- Completed application, transcripts and letter of recommendation must be received by March 1, 2024: Farm Bureau, ATTN: Jennifer Marfio, PO Box 63, Remus MI 49340 or email to Jennifer Marfio at jmarfio@ctyfb.com
- 4. Applicant's ACT or SAT test scores.
- 5. Applicants must submit an essay including:
 - a. Educational and career goals
 - b. The role agriculture has played in your life or the impact it has made.

Awarding and Disbursement:

- 1. The recipient of the scholarship will be determined by the Mecosta County Farm Bureau Board of Directors.
- Money will be awarded after the student has completed their first semester of college following the awarding of the scholarship. Students must maintain a 2.5 GPA or higher. College transcript must be submitted to county office by January 15, 2025.
